2015 Rules & Regulations

- 1) Please keep in mind that this is a "family" parade and all entries must be "G" rated.
- Numbers are to be prominently displayed on your entry and will be issued on the morning of the parade by your stager, in the staging areas.
 If you have a group entry, please be sure that all members of the group know their entry number and staging area prior to parade day.
- 3) Because of the time frame of the parade and the number of entries we have there cannot be any delays or stops for performing. In the interest of safety, throwing items (candy, gifts, etc.) from your parade entrants is not allowed. You need to have enough volunteers to hand items directly to parade watchers at curbside.

 NO THROWING ITEMS FROM YOUR ENTRY. Prescott Frontier Days®, Inc. will not be held responsible for anyone injured by violation of this rule.
- 4) Sign/Banner letters should not be larger than 18 inches. Advertising, identification of floats, and themes should be kept to a minimum and be in good taste. Any advertising that includes the name of a business is considered a "commercial entry" and is subject to the "commercial entry fees".
- 5) All float entries MUST have fire extinguishers.
- 6) All children under the age of twelve (12) years must be accompanied by an adult. All children must be "seated" on any and all types of floats/vehicles.
- 7) Participants "standing" on a float/vehicle must have something stable to hold on to for balance.
- 8) If you will be discharging a weapon Absolutely NO LIVE ROUNDS are allowed!
- 9) Judging of all entries will take place during the Parade. Announcements will be made in the Sunday newspaper and sent by email to parade entrants.
 Parade awards will be ready on parade day. Willis side of Murphys Restaurant.
- 10) Consumption of alcoholic beverages or drugs prior to or during the parade will not be tolerated.
- 11) Horse Entries: Please review the following guidelines:
 - Children under the age of twelve (12) will not be allowed to ride a horse alone during the parade; they must be accompanied by an adult walking or riding alongside them.
 - All children under the age of twelve (12) riding on a horse MUST wear a protective helmet.
 - Any vehicle being pulled by a horse(s) (including, but not limited to a wagon, stagecoach, or trailer) must have an adult walking alongside or riding with the horse(s) to help control the horse(s) throughout the parade route. A safety rope/out-rigging must be attached to the team lead to stop the horse.
 - For safety reasons, only one (1) rider per horse.
 - All equine entrants should be familiar with Arizona Revised Statutes ARS 12-553 concerning Limited liability of equine owners and owners of equine facilities.

* * * PLEASE NOTE THE FOLLOWING REMINDERS * * *

- THE PARADE STARTS PROMPTLY AT 9:00 AM SATURDAY JULY 4TH.
- BECAUSE OF HEAVY TRAFFIC AND STREET CLOSURES PLEASE ALLOW ADEQUATE TIME FOR YOUR ARRIVAL.
- PARTICIPANTS SHOULD BE <u>AT THEIR ASSIGNED STAGING AREA AFTER 7:00AM TO RECEIVE NUMBERS AND LOCATE THEIR POSITIONS. ALL ENTRY PARTICIPANTS SHOULD BE IN POSITION NO LATER THAN 8:00 AM.
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- Parade information will be open at 7:00 am located at the corner of Willis & Marina for Volunteers and parade information.

NO NEED FOR PARADE PARTICIPANTS TO CHECK IN - GO TO YOUR STAGING AREA.

- ALL FLOAT ENTRIES SHOULD HAVE A FIRE EXTINGUISHER ON BOARD
- BRING SUNSCREEN AND COVER --- IT'S GOING TO BE A HOT DAY!!
- FOR THOSE OF YOU WITH ANIMALS BRING WATER FOR THEM AND YOURSELF.
- WE HAVE A LOT OF ENTRIES TO FIT IN THE CITY STREETS, PLEASE BE AWARE OF YOUR SURROUNDINGS AND
 CONSERVE SPACE. YOU CAN SPREAD OUT ON THE PARADE ROUTE FOR PRESENTATION. BECAUSE WE STAGE
 IN THE RESIDENTIAL STREETS, PARADE PARTICIPANTS NEED TO STAY OFF OF PERSONAL PROPERTY AND
 CLEAN UP AFTER THEMSELVES AND THEIR ANIMALS (MANURE AND GARBAGE).
- ONCE YOU HAVE ENTERED THE PARADE ROUTE, MAINTAIN A SAFE DISTANCE BETWEEN THE ENTRY IN FRONT
 OF YOU MOVING AT A SAFE SPEED AND KEEPING A FORWARD MOTION. THERE CANNOT BE DELAYS OR
 STOPPING TO PERFORM.
- No Water Guns Wet pavement for horses and wet people are NOT a good thing!!
- If you will be discharging a weapon absolutely No Live Rounds!
- CANDY OR OTHER ITEMS MAY ONLY BE DISTRIBUTED BY PARADE WALKERS AT CURBSIDE ALONG THE PARADE
 ROUTE. NO THROWING ITEMS FROM YOUR ENTRY.
- No Alcoholic Beverages Will Be Permitted!
- WATER WILL BE AVAILABLE FOR PURCHASE FROM VOLUNTEER GROUPS.
