Webmaster – Dan Marks

There have been several cases when emails from <u>webmaster@perch-base.org</u> have gone into members' junk mail. I recommend members add <u>webmaster@perch-base.org</u> to their contacts list so it will be recognized as a trusted source. If your mail program includes the ability to add a domain to your trusted list, then add the domain perch-base.org so that other emails, such as Flash Traffics from<u>communications@perch-base.org</u> won't go to your junk mail.

Major activity with the website during the past month has been additions of a link to the Meeting Minutes to the Navigation drop-down menu, a Thank You note from Richard Kunze's sister, Margaret, Western Regional Roundup photos, the Annual Picnic photos, Flagstaff Armed Forces Day Parade photos, Memorial Day Ceremony pictures, a link to the ASSM summer raffle promotion, the Linda Wall obituary, the USSVI 54th birthday, updating the Float Maintenance page, and replacement of the membership application with a fillable form. Routine updates during the past month included updating the Sailing Orders page, Flash Traffics and meeting minutes uploaded, Lost Boat notices and Half Staff notices posted and links updated. Similar updates have been maintained on the Perch Base Facebook Group.

During May, there were approximately 1,298 page views on the Perch Base website during 525 sessions by 360 users based on Google Analytics. These numbers are about the slightly higher than usual, probably due to the posting of photos for the increased number of events during the month. The new statistic shows that 13% of the traffic are returning visitors and the other 87% are new visitors to the website. Approximately 74% of the sessions originated in the US, 2% from Canada, 6% from France, 2% from Canada and the remainder were widely scattered around the world. Approximately 36% of the sessions were from locations in Arizona, which is assumed to come from our membership.
