Subject: Memorial Day, Monday, May 29th

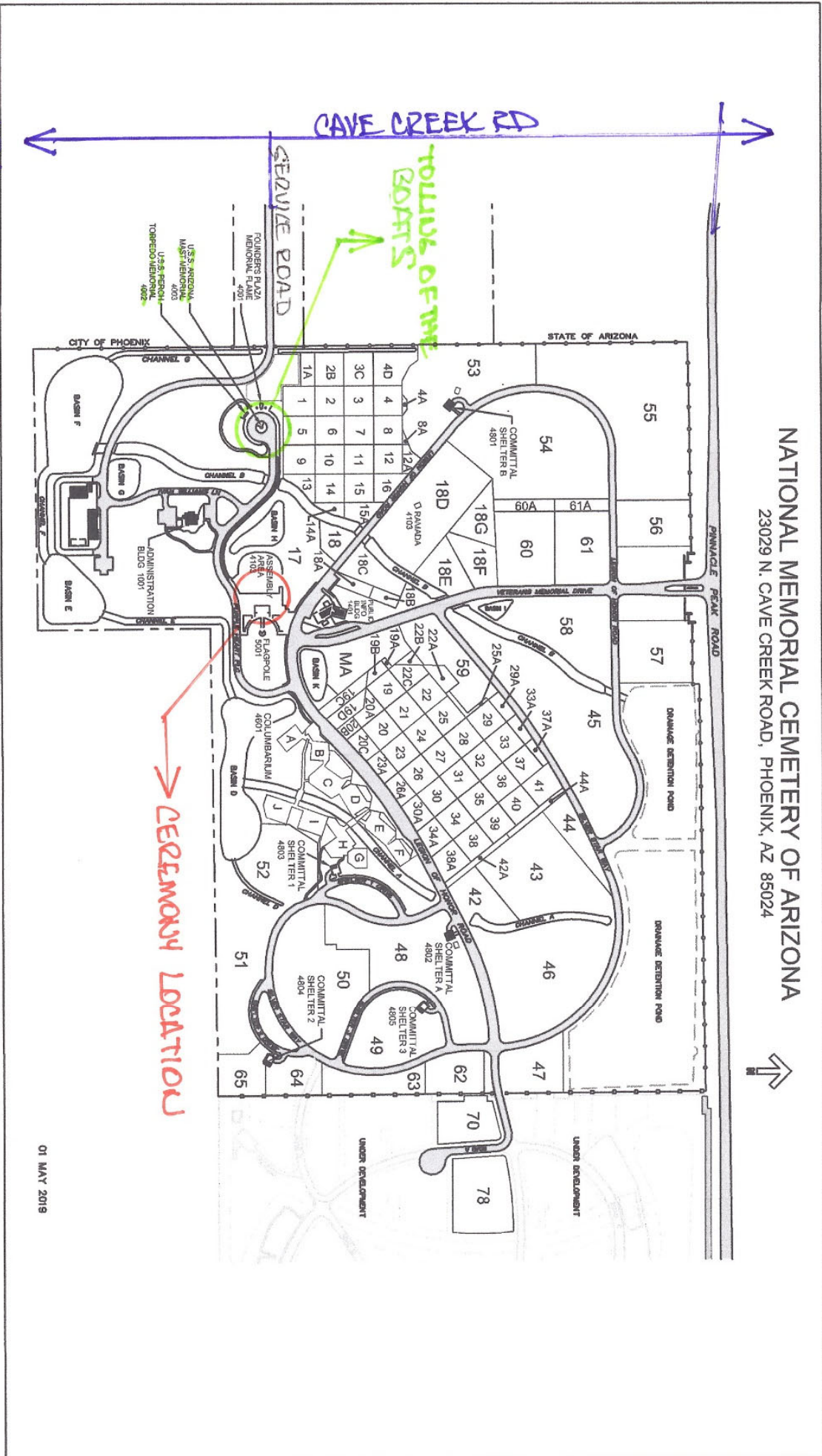
